Kristen Johnson of Batavia Enterprises Feeds the Starving Children

On February 6, 2010, Kristen Johnson, Property Manager at Batavia Enterprises, Inc. (BEI), and 93 other volunteers donated their time to help pack 25,704 meals for Haiti relief. This amazing feat was accomplished through the cooperation of the Batavia Women in Business, Batavia Chamber of Commerce, and the Feed My Starving Children organization.

Over 22 years, Feed My Starving Children has gone from one Minnesota man's idea to a national organization dedicated to supporting over 60 countries in need. The meals delivered to the children were "designed by food scientists at Cargill and General Mills to meet the nutritional needs of a 4-to-8-year-old malnourished child. Each meal has 20 different vitamins and minerals that are specifically tailored to meet a child's nutritional needs for one day (www.fmsc.org)."

On one Saturday morning at the local Aurora center, thanks to the dedication of Johnson and the 93 other volunteers, enough food was packed to feed 71 children for a full year in just two hours. While almost 26,000 meals sounds like a good amount of food, around 100 million packets of food have been requested to feed the children the organization serves on a regular basis.
